POWER CLEAN

Removes old and weathered oil based finishes, treatments and sealers from timber.

Advantages

- Removes weathered oil based finishes, stains, treatments and sealers in as little as 10 minutes
- Apply on any exterior timber surface

Typical Applications

All external timber surfaces.

Coverage

- Approx. 10m² per litre

Application Method

By hose, brush or roller.

Good preparation is key to a professional looking, long lasting finish:

1. Wet surrounding areas and plants before starting.
2. Apply undiluted POWER CLEAN to wet surface using a garden spray, brush or roller. (No thinning required).
3. Allow POWER CLEAN to remain wet on the surface for approximately 10 minutes. (Do not let the product dry on the surface).
4. Using a stiff bristle broom, scrub the surface to see if the coating has lifted.
5. Use a strong jet of water or pressure wash to rinse the surface of the timber. Repeat if necessary.
6. Follow with DEX PREP to neutralise the timber and rid the surface of any darkening which may occur in the cleaning process. (1L DEX PREP : 1L Water).

Failure to thoroughly remove the cleaning solution may result in timber discolouration under clear finishes.
