

# Maintaining your deck regularly will keep it looking great for longer Start by:

- Removing furnishings, pot plants, barbeques and any other items that can be removed off the deck. Items that are too heavy to remove can be covered with a plastic sheet or tarp to protect them from detergent and water. Tip: Remember to clean your
  - protect them from detergent and water. Tip: Remember to clean your outdoor furniture too. Don't put dirty furniture back on the clean deck.
- Sweep your deck. Give your deck a good brush to help keep the surface free from loose dirt, soil, leaves, sticks and other decking contaminates. Tip: If organic debris is left for long periods of times it can begin to decompose and become acidic, causing damage to your deck.
- Wash the deck. Washing your deck will minimise any build-up of moss, mould or alage regrowth.
- Use a neutral pH Cleaner to clean your deck.

- If the cleaning water runs directly into your garden using a non-toxic and ecofriendly pH neutral cleaner. Using either a bristle brush and some good old fashioned elbow grease scrub the deck or opt for a power wash. Repeat if necessary. Tip: Clean railings during the same time.
- Use a garden hose to rinse off remaining suds.
- Once the deck is dry. Look for signs of tattiness and coating wear and tear. Inspect and identify any problem areas. Check for loose, split or rotten boards. Repair or fix new boards back into place. If possible, replace any rusty screws or nails, as these can lead to discolouration of the deck and may cause the timber to become loose.
- If the coating exhibits signs of wear and tear - it's time for a recoat.
   Prepare and recoat the deck according to label directions and technical datasheets. If the coating shows no wear and tear add the furnishings and other items back to the deck. Tip: Need help to determine which preparation product you require.

- Recoat your deck with Quantum's decking TIMBRE PLUS DECKING. Tip: Follow all coating applications details on the label and datasheets.





 Make sure your deck is completely dry before moving your furnishings, pot plants, barbeques back to the deck. Be sure to take



- care of scratching scuffing and marring when moving heavy objects backs. Tip: Do not drag furniture across the deck.

- Use floor protectors on furniture legs.
- Keep pet claws trimmed to minimise scratching.
